

COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The College of Engineering awards scholarships to selected qualified students that major in engineering, computer science, and engineering technology subdisciplines. Scholarships in the college are supported by individuals, foundations, industries, corporations, and governmental agencies. Recipients receive awards that are a minimum of \$1000 per academic year, depending on the availability of funds. Awards are renewed by the college scholarship committee each semester, following a review of the student's academic performance for adherence to the qualifications criteria in this guideline. The UNT College of Engineering is committed to the goals of Texas Higher Education Plan, Closing the Gaps, in diverse participation for all Texans and ethnic backgrounds.

The College of Engineering Scholarship Committee selects scholarship recipients based on a holistic evaluation that includes the following criteria and additional extracurricular activities.

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIRED MATERIALS FOR CONSIDERATION

Incoming Freshmen Must:

1. Declare a major in the College of Engineering and be enrolled with a minimum of 15 credit hours in the first semester including a required mathematics course listed in the major's degree plan.
2. Have a minimum high school grade point average of 3.2 (on a 4.0 scale)
3. have a minimum 1200 SAT I (combined Critical Reading/Verbal + Math) or 27 ACT

Interested students must submit by March 1, evidence of the qualifications, official seven semester high school transcripts, two letters of recommendation from a mathematics or science instructor.

Transfer Students Must:

1. Be accepted as a full-time student in an Engineering Program at UNT
2. Have a minimum college-level cumulative grade point average of 3.2 (on a 4.0 scale)
3. Have Passed College of Engineering required mathematics and science courses
4. Be in good standing at the transfer institution

Interested students must submit evidence of qualifications, official transcripts from all colleges attended, and two letters of recommendation which at least one is from a professor from the student's major discipline or faculty advisor by March 1.

Current Undergraduate Students Must:

1. Be accepted as a full-time student in an Engineering program at UNT
2. Have a minimum UNT cumulative grade point average of 3.2 (on a 4.0 scale)
3. Be in good standing at the University

All undergraduates must pass minimum 30 semester credit hours per academic year as "progress towards degree."

Interested students must submit official college transcripts from all colleges attended, two letters of recommendation, at least one of which is from a professor from the student's major discipline or faculty advisor, and an application form by the **March 1**.

Graduate Students:

Scholarship award to graduate students will be decided on the following criteria:

1. GPA
2. GRE
3. Degree sought
4. Area of concentration (i.e., is this a research area that the 'faculty' is involved in).
5. Letters of recommendation
